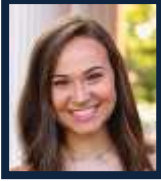

## Anchor President-Elect



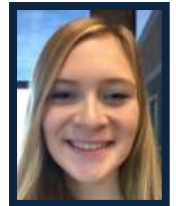
