



I wanted to share a few of the exciting highlights of the meeting. The Anchor leaders elected to go with a Disney Theme with the title of "Anchors....A Magical Night on a Carpet Ride". Plans are underway for an icebreaker on Friday evening with a Lip Sync contest this year. Workshops were named as Self Defense, Arts & Crafts (bring back the hospital art!), Financial Planning/Budgeting, and Zumba. In regard to food at the conference, we have been able to negotiate and resolve all the bullets noted on the evaluations at no additional cost.
