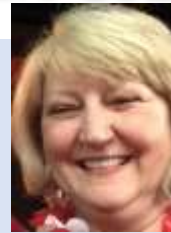

I am honored to serve as your Governor Elect this year and hope you will feel free to call on me to assist in any way. I look forward to us "Making a Difference" together!

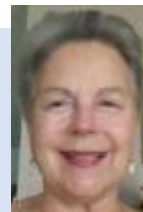


Genia Mitchell
