Pilot Club Information

The Georgia Pilot Foundation, Inc. will award up to five \$1,500 scholarships to graduating seniors who are members of an Anchor Club in the Georgia District of Pilot International.

Only one application per Anchor Club will be considered by the Scholarship Committee. The sponsoring Pilot Club's Scholarship Committee is responsible for selecting and submitting one entry if there are multiple applicants from an Anchor Club. Before submitting the application, the sponsoring Pilot Club should verify that the Anchor Club has paid their Pilot International and Georgia District Anchor dues, that the applicant is complete and signed by the Pilot Youth Coordinator.

Requirements:

- 1) Be a graduating senior in good standing of a GA District Anchor Club
- 2) Have a minimum of a 3.0 or B academic average
- 3) Plan to continue education at an accredited college or university
- 4) Have paid all required Pilot International and Georgia District dues for the current Pilot year
- 5) Be recommended by your sponsoring Pilot Club or Anchor Advisor

The Scholarship Committee consisting of 4 Georgia District Pilots will review all scholarship applications. GPF scholarships will be awarded based upon the following criteria:

- 1) Anchor participation
- 2) Academic excellence and achievements
- 3) Community, civic, church, or school volunteer activities
- 4) Financial Need

Scholarship winners will be announced at the Georgia District Anchor Convention in February 2026. The scholarships will be awarded at the Awards Luncheon at the Georgia District Pilot Convention (Saturday, May 2, 2026). **Scholarship recipients must be present to receive their scholarship award.**

It will be the responsibility of the sponsoring Pilot Club to send in a District Convention registration form with payment for the Awards Luncheon to the Georgia District Treasurer for their student (and their parents if attending) to attend the Awards Luncheon. Please also send a copy to the GPF Representative. The students will sit with their sponsoring Pilot Club members at the Awards Luncheon.

Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college or university of the student's choice payable to the student and the college or university. Any unused funds must be returned to the Georgia Pilot Foundation, Inc by the college or university.

The Scholarship Committee will score only complete applications submitted to GPF. One application per Anchor Club should be emailed to the District GPF Representative no later than **January 24**, **2026**, to:

- 1) Attached application completed and signed by school counselor or principal, student, and sponsoring Pilot Club Anchor Coordinator or Anchor Advisor
- 2) 1 page essay on your Anchor and other volunteer service
- 3) Official high school grade transcript
- 4) Letters of recommendations from the following:
 - One (1) letter from the Anchor advisor or a Pilot Club member who has knowledge of your Anchor participation
 - A minimum of two (2) letters from a teacher, school counselor, clergyman, employer, Pilot member or other community leader who has knowledge of your Anchor or other volunteer activities

Incomplete applications will not be scored by the Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship winners will be announced at the Georgia District Anchor Convention in February 2026. The scholarships will be awarded at the Awards Luncheon at the Georgia District Pilot Convention (Saturday, May 2, 2026). Scholarship recipients must be present to receive their scholarship award.
