Nominees must have been a member in Pilot International for at least 10 years, and be a current active member in good standing of a Pilot Club within the Georgia District. Evaluation of nominees will be based upon their involvement with Pilot during the last five years, including participation in District events; exemplary participation in at least three of the four divisions within their club; active involvement within their local community; and embodiment of the core values of Pilot International.

Individuals may receive the award only once. Complete this form for the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2026.
